Mae Sprunger Dies Monday

Funeral services for Mrs. Mae Bertha Sprunger, 75, a lifelong resident here who died at the Cooper Rest Home at Decatur at 1 pm Monday will be held Thursday at 2 pm at the Yager Funeral Home here. The Rev. Kenneth Overmeyer, pastor of the Trinity EUB Church of which Mrs. Sprunger was a faithful member, will officiate. Burial will be in the MRE Cemetery.

Mrs. Sprunger had been failing in health since July 2, 1965 and was a patient at the Adams County Memorial Hospital many months before she was moved to the rest home.

She was born in Berne October 3, 1891, a daughter of Ulysses and Kathryn Gerig-Stauffer, and was married to Menno Sprunger March 25, 1917. Her husband preceded her in death in 1952. They had resided on E. Water Street for many years.

Surviving are four sons, Weldon L. Sprunger of Pondagora, Fla., Leland W. Sprunger of Philadelphia, and Loren V. and Paul J. Sprunger, both of Berne; three daughters, Mrs. Kenneth (Janice) Hoffman of Monroe, Mrs. James (Evelyn) Hart of near Monroe, and Mrs. Leland (Areta) Bishop of Berne; one brother, William E.
