Marjorie "Marge" R. Sprunger, 75, of Berne, passed away at 11:20 am Tuesday, October 12, 2010 at Select Specialty Hospital, Fort Wayne. She was born in Berne on August 28, 1935 to Calvin A. and Lulu (Stuckey) Sprunger, both deceased. Marge graduated from Berne French High School in 1953 and Lutheran Nursing School in 1956.
