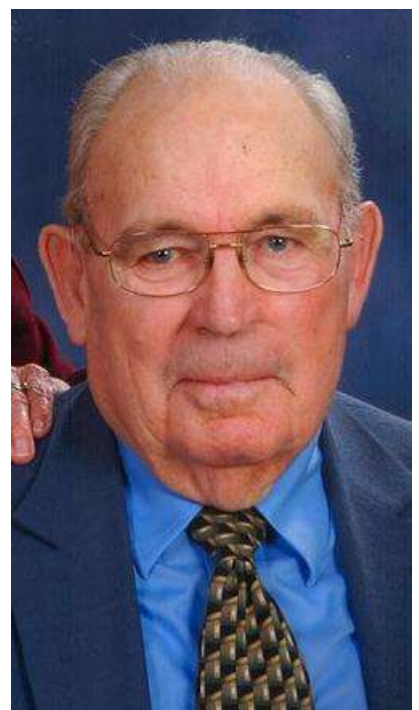


Stanley K. Sprunger
