

DEATH CLAIMS ANNA STAUFFER

Former Resident of This Community dies at County Infirmary

Mon. Feb. 26, 1934

Miss Anna Elizabeth Stauffer, aged 76, died at the Adams County Infirmary at 4:30 Saturday morning following an eight years' illness of cancer.

The deceased had been a resident at the infirmary since May 22, 1912.

Miss Stauffer was born in Switzerland, August 20, 1856. She came to the United States in 1886 and for a number of years made her home in the community about Berne.

Two brothers, Fred Stauffer of near Berne and Gottlieb Stauffer of California; two sisters, Mrs. Magdalene Christener of near Monroe, and one sister, still living in Switzerland, survive.

The body was taken to the S.E. Black funeral home at Decatur and was removed to the infirmary today noon where funeral services were held this afternoon at 1:30 o'clock, with the Rev. Charles Prugh, pastor of the Zion Reformed church of Decatur, officiating. Burial was made in the M. R. E. cemetery near Berne.
