### Mrs. Ulysses Stauffer Dies Here Early Wednesday

Mrs. Ulysses Stauffer, aged 7?, died at 4:00 at her home on East Water Street, Wednesday morning. She had been in poor health for two years and had been bedfast for a week. The cause of her death was attributed to infirmities of old age. The deceased was born on a farm near Vera Cruz, February 7, 18[65], the daughter of Ulrich and Katharine Miller Gehrig. Her marriage to Mr. Stauffer was an event of November 7, 18?? and took place in Berne. She was a resident of Berne ever since her marriage and of this county for ? years.

Surviving besides the husband are two children, Mrs. Menno (Mae) Sprunger of this place and William of Fort Wayne. Two children died in infancy. Eight grandchildren survive.

Brothers and sisters surviving are Mrs. Frank Mosure, Vera Cruz, Mrs. Hosea Martz, Berne, Mrs. Daniel Amstutz, Fort Recovery, O, and a half-brother, John Grim, of Michigan. Brothers and sisters preceding are Mrs. Christian Kuntz, Edward, Mrs. Henry Myers and Mrs. Benedict Mosure.

Funeral services will be conducted Friday afternoon at 1:30 at the home and at 2:00 at the Evangelical church where she was a member. Rev. M.O. Herman, pastor of the church will officiate. Burial will be made in the M. R. E. cemetery.
