Albert Steiner Dies today at Swiss Village

Funeral Sunday for Retired Farmer, 76

Albert Steiner, 76, a retired farmer of R. R. One, Geneva, died at 12:05 AM today at Swiss Village where he resided the past few weeks. He had been in failing health for several weeks, and in between residency at Swiss Village, spent some time in the Adams County Memorial Hospital.

His death was the first one at Swiss Village, and followed a series of strokes.

Mr. Steiner was a lifelong resident of this community and spent many years on his farm in Hartford Township. He was born December 2, 1892 in Monroe Township, a son of Peter D. and Barbara Mosier Steiner. He was married to Lydia Yoder on November 6, 1915. She preceded in death May 15, 1968.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Howard (Luella) Moeschberger, R. R. 1, Berne and Mrs. Kenneth E. (Lorena) Wanner, R. R. 2, Geneva; four grandchildren; 2 great-grandchildren; a brother, John S. Steiner, Geneva, R. R. 1 and a sister, Mrs. Cyrus (Kate) Lehman, Berne. Deceased brothers and sisters are Levi, Amos, Dan, Noah, Ezra, Sam, Sarah, Judith, and Emma.
