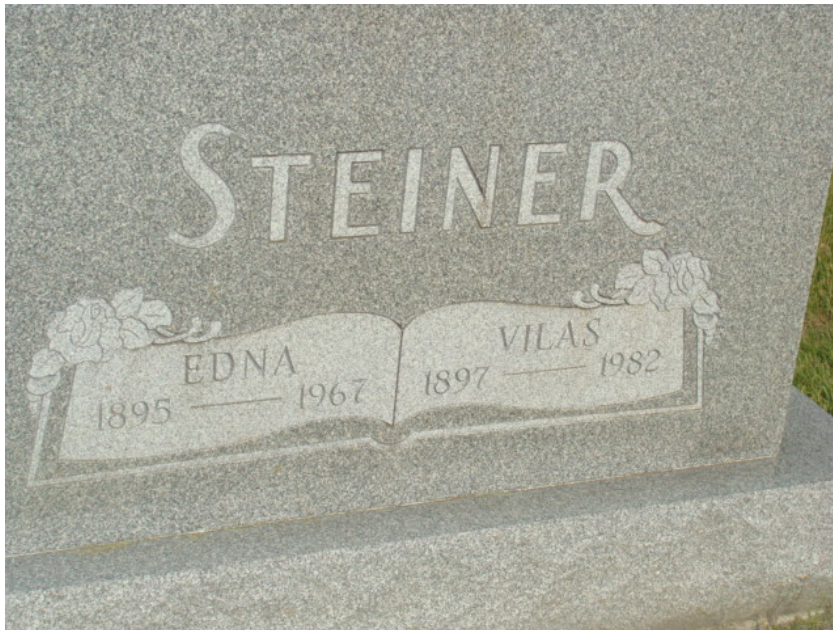

Funeral Today for Wife of Vilas Steiner

Stroke Fatal to Mrs. Edna Steiner, 72

Mrs. Edna Steiner, 72, wife of Vilas Steiner of Berne R.R. 1, died at 9:25 pm Friday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital. She was admitted to the hospital late Friday afternoon after suffering a cerebral hemorrhage in her home along State Highway 218 west of Berne. She had not been well since the first of the year, but was up and around until Friday.

She was born in French Township February 7, 1895 and was a lifelong resident of this community. She was a daughter of Fred and Aldine Gerber Dubach. She was married to Vilas Steiner December 24, 1922, in Berne. Their home had been demolished by the Palm Sunday, 1965 tornado.

Surviving are the husband; a son, Merlin Steiner, Berne R. R. 1; two daughters, Miss Betty Steiner, at home and Mrs. Tom (Dorothy) Weaver, Geneva R. R. 1; six grandchildren and two brothers, Calvin Dubach, Berne and Elmer Dubach, Geneva R.R. 1. A son, Elmer, died at the age of three and a brother is deceased.

Services were held at 2 pm today at the First Mennonite Church, where she was a member. Rev. Gordon J. Neuenschwander and Rev. Gerald Stucky officiated and burial was in the MRE Cemetery. The Yager Funeral Home had charge of the service.
