Wife of Clyde Striker Dies Late Tuesday

Funeral here Friday For 71-Year-Old Woman

Mrs. Elease Striker, 71, Geneva, R.R. 2, died late Tuesday afternoon at the home of Betty and Helen Anderson, near Geneva, where she had been cared for the past two years. Death was attributed to a coronary occlusion. Mrs. Striker, a lifelong resident of this community, had been in failing health for seven years.

She was born in French Township, July 7, 1896, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Gottlieb Hanni. She was married to Clyde Striker, March 23, 1918, in Berne.

Surviving in addition to the husband are two daughters, Mrs. Ray (Joan) Conn of Fort Wayne and Miss Harriett Striker of Geneva R.R. 2; six grandchildren; two brothers, Adolph Hannie, Monroe and Harry Hannie, Fort Wayne; four sisters, Mrs. Harry (Lisetta) Heffner, Bryant R.R.; Mrs. Floyd (Lydia) Shoaf who resides in Florida; Mrs. Martha Shoaf, Decatur, R.R. 6 and Mrs. Leo (Edna) Chausse, Fort Wayne. A son, Richard Striker died a few months ago and four brothers, Albert, Alfred, Carl and Milton Hannie preceded in death.
