Howard Stucky, 81, a resident of Tucson, Arizona, died April 11 in Tucson, following a six week battle with cancer.

A member of the Trinity Presbyterian Church, Stucky graduated from Earlham College in Richmond in 1929. He began his career in YMCA at Richmond and continued in this work 40 years. He retired from the Tucson YM-YWCA in 1969, becoming director of the Old Pueblo Boys' Club and retired in 1978 from that work. He continued to be very active in church work and Swap Meet hobbies until his death.

Born in Adams County, May 3, 1904, he was the son of the late Daniel and Marianne (Sprunger) Stucky. He was married to Imogene Minnix and she survives.

Surviving besides the wife are one son, Byron W. Stucky, Tucson, Arizona; one daughter, Mary Lou Charlton, Arizona; one sister, Mrs. Marcus (Linda) Moser, Berne; and six grandchildren. Ten brothers preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be conducted in Tucson on Tuesday, April 15 at 2 p.m. in the Trinity Presbyterian Church with Bring Funeral Home of Tucson in charge of arrangements.

Funeral services will then be held in the Yager-Kirchhofer Funeral Home of Berne on Saturday, April 19 at 2 p.m. with Rev. Ken Bauman officiating, Burial will follow in the MRE Cemetery, west of Berne.
