

## **Decatur Daily Democrat, Adams County, Indiana; Monday, March 28, 1977**

Mrs. Irene M. Stucky, 73, Hobbs, New Mexico but a resident of Berne most of her life, died at 3:25 p.m. Saturday at the Roswell Hospital, Roswell, New Mexico. She had been ill since Thursday and death resulted from complications following surgery.

Mrs. Stucky had not been well for several years and since that time had resided with her daughter in New Mexico. She moved to New Mexico six years ago.

She and her late husband, Menno Stucky, operated a department store in Berne for a number of years prior to Mr. Stucky's death in 1956.

She was born in Adams County January 16, 1904, a daughter of Peter and Sarah Snyder Mosser. She was married to Menno Stucky, Oct. 16, 1922, in Berne.

Mrs. Stucky was a member of the West Missionary Church.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Roger (Vera) Luginbill, Hobbs, New Mexico; a son, Bill W. Stucky, Bloomington; four grandchildren; two great-grandchildren and two sisters, Mrs. Emerson (Mildred) Neuenschwander, Bradenton, Florida and Esther Rothaar, Dayton, Ohio. A brother, Harold Mosser and a sister, Lila, preceded her in death.

The body is being returned to Berne and friends may call at the Yager Funeral Home Tuesday from 2 to 9 p.m. and on Wednesday from 9 a.m. until time of the service at 2 p.m. Wednesday. Rev. Mark A. Batterbee, pastor of the West Missionary Church will officiate and burial will be in the M.R.E. Cemetery.
