Widow of Erwin Stucky, 78, Dies Late Wednesday

Funeral Here Saturday for Monroe Woman, 78

Mrs. Martha Stucky, 78, 237 West Washington St., Monroe, died at 10:40 PM Wednesday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital in Decatur, five hours after being admitted. Death was attributed to a heart attack. Mrs. Stucky was stricken in her home early in the evening, after spending some time in the Stucky Furniture Company store during the afternoon. She was taken by ambulance to the hospital. Mrs. Stucky had prepared for supper and was planning to accompany Mrs. Adolph Hannie to Swiss Village west of Berne to visit Mr. Hannie.

Mrs. Stucky, known prominently throughout the area, had not been ill. She was the widow of Erwin Stucky, former Monroe businessman, who died suddenly March 1, 1966, while in route home by plane from a trip to Arizona.

She was a member of the First Mennonite Church in Berne, the Adams County Home Economics Club of which she was a former President, State Council of Roadside Parks, the WCTU and the WSCS of the Monroe Methodist Church.

Mrs. Stucky was born in Monroe Township, September 20, 1892, a daughter of Mathias and Mary Ann Galli Liechty. She was married August 15, 1914.

Surviving are two sons, Glen and Earl Stucky, both of Monroe; two daughters, Mrs. Roger (Erline) Bluhm, Monroe and Mrs. Ralph (Fern) Hannie, Fort Wayne; 11 grandchildren; nine great-

grandchildren and a brother, Carl Liechty, Columbus, Ohio. Six sisters and five brothers preceded in death.
