## SHELDON WAGLEY DIES SUDDENLY

Sheldon J. Wagley, 64, of route 6, prominent Adams County farmer, died suddenly at 9 p.m. Thursday at the Fort Wayne Lutheran Hospital. Mr. Wagley suffered a fatal heart attack. He was a member of the Monroe United Methodist Church, Decatur Lodge 571 F & AM, Scottish Rite, York Rite, Shrine and Rotary.

Born in Cambridge, Iowa, on Dec. 15, 1908, he was the son of Ludwig and Anna Sheldahl Wagley, and was married on June 4, 1938 (or 1933) to Dorothy A. Beam.
