

Muriel Ruth Williams, 98, formerly of Wabash, died at 7:00 A.M. Tuesday, December 4, 2012, at her niece's home in Kansas City, Missouri. She was born March 5, 1914 in Greeley, Nebraska, to George and Viva Kelley Baldwin.

Muriel was a 1933 graduate of Argonia High School in Argonia, Kansas. She attended Colorado Springs Bible College in Colorado and graduated from Asbury College in Wilmore, Kentucky. She received her Masters degree from Ball State University in Muncie, Indiana.

She married Max G. Williams in Indianapolis, Indiana, on November 28, 1953; he died May 26, 1999.

She was an elementary school teacher, teaching at Poplar Bluff in Bluffton, Indiana, and Lancaster Elementary in Huntington County, Indiana, retiring in 1980.
