Mrs. Cassie Winteregg, 93, Dies Tuesday

Funeral for Local Woman at 2 PM Thursday

Mrs. Henry (Cassie) Winteregg, 93, of 405 Sprunger Street, died shortly after 12 o'clock noon Tuesday at the Berne Nursing Home where she had been a patient since the latter part of February. Prior to that she had been a patient for a month in the Adams County Memorial Hospital at Decatur. She had been bedfast since December. The cause of death was given as cardiac failure.

Her husband, Henry, a former town official, died December 4th, 21 days before they could have celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary. They were married December 25, 1902. Mr. and Mrs. Winteregg, as long as health permitted, were widely known for their beautiful vegetable and flower gardens.

Mrs. Winteregg was born in French Township April 11, 1875, the daughter of David and Catherine Schlatter-Schindler. Excepting when the deceased attended what is now Fort Wayne Bible College and several years service with the Christian Missionary Alliance orphanage, College Point, New York City, and several years in Hesperia, Michigan, she resided in Berne.

Mrs. Winteregg was a member of the First Missionary Church. Many years of ill health prevented attendance at the church but her devoutness invariably found her tuned in for worship through the wired-in system which brought messages of hope, comfort and reassurance from the pastors, whose Missionary Church Parsonage was next door. Up to near the time of her death, she had a remarkable keen mind and (cut off).
