Widow of Frank Brewster Dies At Wooster, O.
Rites Here Tuesday For Former Berne Woman

Mrs. Anna Brewster, 80, a resident of Berne and community for 50 years, died at her home in Wooster, Ohio Sunday afternoon. She resided at 2799 Cleveland Road in Wooster and had lived in that city for 30 years. Death was sudden.

She was born in Adams county January 4, 1888, a daughter of J. L. and Arabelle Garrison Sipe. She was married to Frank D. Brewster March 25, 1905. He preceded in death a number of years ago. Mr. Brewster was a Berne insurance agent and real estate dealer for many years.

Surviving are a son, Joe Brewster, Fort Wayne; a daughter, Mrs. Herman (Annabel) Mays, Jr., Wooster, Ohio; a foster daughter, Mrs. Russell, (Hulda) Blocker, Marion; four grandchildren and four great-grandchildren; a brother, Chauncey Sipe, Berne and two sisters, Mrs. Jess (Minnie) Snyder, Muncie and Mrs. Frank (Jennie) Merriman, Monroe.

Two daughters, Mrs. Nelson (Beatrice) Schug and Minnie are deceased. Mrs. Schug died in 1962 and Minnie in 1922.

Mrs. Brewster was a member of the Wooster Baptist Temple.

Services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Yager Funeral home. Rev. Gordon Neuenschwander, pastor of the First Mennonite church, will officiate. Friends may call at the funeral home. Burial will be in Riverside cemetery at Geneva.
