A funeral service for Vern Huffman, 82, a retired area teacher, was to be held at 2 p.m. today at the Wiley Funeral Home in Granbury, Texas.

Interment will be at a later date in Riverside Cemetery at Geneva, Ind.

Mr. Huffman, a resident of Granbury since 1991, died Wednesday, Feb.27, in a Fort Worth, Texas hospital.

He taught school for 30 years in Fort Wayne, Geneva and Bryant, Indiana. He was a graduate of Ball State University, where he received several awards. He also was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II.

Mr. Huffman was a member of the First United Methodist Church and Indiana Masonic Lodge. He was an avid antique collector and dealer.

He was born in Wells County March 23, 1919 and was married on Aug. 31, 1940 in Randolph to Jean Stanley, who survives.

Surviving also are a daughter Pamela Wood of Lincoln, Neb.; a son, Terry D. Huffman of Terrell, Texas; a sister Mabel Carpenter of Woodville, Ind.; a brother, Edward Huffman of Fort Wayne; four granddaughters; and five great-grandchildren.
