Funeral services for L.A. "Gus" Mann, 91, will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday at Downing & Glancy Funeral Home in Geneva. Visitation hours at the funeral home will be Friday from 3 to 5 and 7 to 8 p.m. and Saturday for two hours prior to services.

Mr. Mann, a retired real estate agent in Geneva, died at 6:30 a.m. Wednesday, Dec. 11, at the Swiss Village Retirement Center in Berne. Mr. Mann was an agent for Midwestern United Life Insurance, retiring after 40 years. He also retired after 60 years as a realtor in Geneva. He served for eight years as trustee in Wabash Township, Adams County, was engaged as a builder and developer of Rainbow Lake in Geneva, had donated ground for the Wabash Valley Golf Course in Geneva and was the recipient of the Limberlost Heritage Award. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church at Geneva, a 50-year member of Geneva Masonic Lodge 621, and member of the Mizpah Temple in Fort Wayne.

Mr. Mann was born in Adams County Sept. 23, 1911, a son of William R. and Carrie D. Miller Mann. His marriage at Berne on Nov. 14, 1936 was to Olive E. Huser, who survives. Additional survivors are a daughter, Mrs. Robert (Evelyn) Waters of Weslaco, Texas; a son, John L. Mann of Geneva; four grandchildren; and 10 great-grandchildren. A brother and seven sisters are deceased.
