The Adams County native owned Pleasant Ridge Jersey Farm and won a first-place national award for his registered Jersey. He was a director of the Adams County Co-op for 34 years, and also a director of the Indiana State Dairy Association, Adams County Farm Bureau, Adams County Extension Board, Adams County Soil and Water Conservation Board and Riverside Cemetery Association. He was Jefferson Township trustee for eight years, and member of the Indiana and American Jersey Cattle associations and Wayne Co-op Milk Association.

Surviving are his wife, Catherine; a daughter, Judi K. Merkel of Geneva; a son, Ronnie L. of Losantville; sisters, Catherine Knapp of Indianapolis and Grace Dubach of Geneva; seven grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.
