was on the Marion City Council from 1967-71 and 1975-79 and served as council president. He was born in Decatur in 1928 to Miles F. and Izora H. Roop; the mother, a Marion resident, is among the survivors. He was a 1946 graduate of Berne High School, a veteran of the U.S Army Air Corps in World War II, and a realtor and advertising

agency owner for 31 years in Marion. Also surviving are one son; two daughters; four

stepsons, including Robert Dull, Geneva; and two grandchildren.
