Delight Sills, 98, Leo, a Geneva native, died Saturday at The Cedars in Leo.

Born on June 17, 1909, in Geneva, to Samuel J. Tilden and Bertha Alice (Buckey) Weaver, she graduated from Augusta High School in Kansas in 1927. She was married on Feb. 16, 1935, in Geneva, to Charles Edward Sills, who died in April of 1973.
