Former Wabash Twp. School Teacher Dies
Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. W. R. Mann Dies; Rites Tuesday

Mrs. Rose Mann Vogan, aged 34, a native of Wabash Township, and a former schoolteacher in that Township, died at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon in Cleveland, Ohio, following an illness of three weeks, and an operation.

Mrs. Vogan formally taught at the Fravel School in Wabash Township, and also at District No. 1.

The deceased was born in Wabash Township, the daughter of William and Belle Miller Mann. She was a member of the Methodist Church in Cleveland, the Order of Eastern Star and the Daughters of America.

Survivors include the husband, Herbert Vogan, of Cleveland; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. William R. Mann, northeast of Geneva; six sisters, Mrs. Frank Farlow and Mrs. Dora Anspaugh, Geneva; Mrs. Joseph Schaad, Rockford, Ohio; Mrs. Archie Becher and Mrs. H. H. Bean of Fort Wayne; Mrs. Gaylord Dennison, Van Nuys, California, and two brothers, L. Guss Man of Wabash Township, and F. Ray Mann, of Idaho.

The body was returned to the home of her parents in Wabash Township today. The funeral will be held at 2 PM Tuesday in Geneva, M. E. Church, burial in Riverside Cemetery.

Rose Vogan died Saturday, Nov. 19, 1938 at age 34, a resident of 1484 Sherbrook Rd. South Euclid, Ohio. Her husband, William Herbert Vogan was born Oct 8, 1903 in Northern Ireland and died Sunday May 3, 1964 in at Glendale, Los Angeles Co, CA at age 61. His 2nd wife, Thelma, born May 27, 1906, died July 4, 1995 in Los Angeles, CA.

William was chief inspection engineer of the American Gas Association laboratories, Los Angeles Calif. He had been manager of the Pacific Coast branch laboratories since 1949. He left Cleveland in 1939. He was survived by his 2nd wife, Thelma, and a brother.

Rose's funeral was Sunday, Nov. 20, 1938 at the Saxton Funeral Home, 13215 Detroit Ave; interment in Geneva, Indiana. William's funeral was May 6, 1964 in Glendale, CA; burial in Forest Lawn Memorial Park, Glendale, CA.
