

Mrs. Pearl Shaw is taken by death

Mrs. Pearl Shaw, 65, of 121 North 15th street, was pronounced dead on arrival at the Adams county memorial hospital at 10:45 a.m. Monday. She had been in failing health for several years and had been hospitalized for the past seven weeks. She had been dismissed from the hospital Sunday evening but became ill again Monday morning. She was born in Adams county Aug. 22, 1902, a daughter of John and Elizabeth Topp-Hendricks. Her first husband, Vinton Ray, preceded her in death in 1940.
