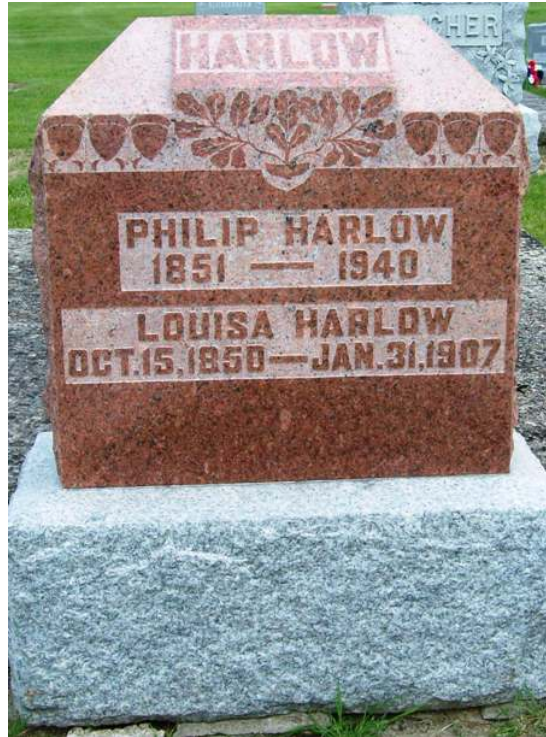

PHILIP HARLOW, 88, ANSWERS SUMMONS
Rites For Father of Former County Auditor Are Thursday P.M.

Philip Harlow, 88, father of Albert Harlow, former county auditor, died at his home west of Geneva of infirmities at 11:15 p.m. Monday following a three weeks' illness. He was a retired farmer and had been a resident of this county for 60 years.

The decedent was born in Decatur county on June 3, 1851. His wife passed away 35 years ago. No brothers or sisters survive, four having preceded.

The final rites will be held at Geneva U.B. church of which he was a member, at 1:30 Thursday afternoon. The Rev. Bennet Fulp, assisted by Rev. Dwight Lusk, of Saratoga, will officiate. Burial will be in the West Lawn cemetery.
