

Dr. Clarence Hinchman Dies

Rites Are Held Today At Geneva, Ind.

Rites were held today at Geneva, Ind., for Dr. Clarence Hinchman, 68, a native of Fairview Township, who died late Friday night in Ball Memorial Hospital, Muncie. His parents were the late U.
