Eugene M. Lindsey, 93, Dies Sunday

Eugene M. Lindsey, 93, a resident of this community for 69 years and prominent in the affairs of the area until advancing years forced his retirement from active participation, died at 2:30 a.m. Sunday at his home west of Geneva after a six-months illness. Mr. Lindsey was born in Deerfield, Jay County, the son of Festus and Martha Lindsey. He came to the Geneva community after his marriage to Rofina Bolds, October 2, 1887, settling on the farm four miles west of town where he lived the rest of his life, actively engaging farming for half a century. Surviving are the widow, Rofina; three sons Ralph Lindsey, Fort Wayne, IN, Charley Lindsey, Geneva, and Milo Lindsey, Maumee, Ohio; eight grandchildren; eighteen great-grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs. Elizabeth Fouts, Baltimore, Maryland. A brother, Fred E. Lindsey, a barber in Geneva for about 50 years, died here a few years ago. Funeral services were held at 1:00 p.m. Tuesday at the Hardy Funeral Home in Geneva, Rev. Roger Laufzenhiser of Elkhart, former pastor of Geneva Methodist Church, officiating. Interment was in West Lawn Cemetery.
