Mrs. F. E. Pelham, Formerly Miss Effie Reicheldeffer of Geneva, Succumbs

Decatur, Ind., Jan. 12 – Mrs. Frank E. Pelham, formerly Miss Effie Reicheldeffer, of Geneva, a bride of a few months, died suddenly last night at 10 o'clock at her home in Shelbyville, according to a report received here by friends. Her death was caused by heart trouble and comes as a surprising shock to all. Mrs. Pelham was well known over the county, having at one time been one of its popular school teachers. She was married only last October 8 by the Rev. C. B. Wilcox, pastor of the Methodist church, of this city, and went thereafter with her husband to Shelbyville, where he was employed as a pharmacist. She was but twenty-two years of age and was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Reicheldeffer, of Geneva. The body will be brought to Geneva at midnight tonight, where the funeral will be held.
