Former Owner Geneva Herald Dies Thursday

C. O. Rayn, Prominent Insurance Man Dies; Rites Sunday

Geneva, May 8 - Clarence O. Rayn, 69, well known Geneva insurance man, and former owner of the Geneva Herald, died at his home on Shackley Street at 4:00 o'clock Thursday afternoon. Death was attributed to heart disease with which he had suffered during the past year and a half.

The deceased was born in Bearcreek Township, Jay County, February 7, 1873, the son of Alexander and Caroline (Mendenhall) Rayn. He was reared on a farm and later was a student at the University at Ada, Ohio.
