Isaac Teeple, son of James and Mary Smith Teeple, was born May 7, 1855 and departed this life June 5, 1933, aged 78 years and 28 days.

He was born near Bobo, in Adams county and excepting about two years spent his entire life in this county.

On October 20, 1878, he was united in marriage to Rachel Moser and to this union were born the following children: David, James, Joe, Ray, Paul, Mrs. John Wood of Sherwood, Mich., Mrs. Clyde Ray, Convoy, Ohio and two other daughters who died in infancy.

Surviving are the wife, Mrs. Rachel Teeple, 7 children, 20 grandchildren, 2 great grandchildren and two sisters, Mrs. Sarah Ayres, Monroe, Ind., and Mrs. Catherine Case, Willshire, Ohio.

Mr. Teeple's main life work was farming and buying and selling stock. He was a man devoted to this family, toiling for them early and late. He was a kind neighbor, one in whose integrity all had confidence.
