

**Decatur Daily Democrat, Adams Co, IN; Monday, August 22, 1977**

Delmas W. Feasel, 70, of 1064 Parkview Drive, a retired General Electric Co. employe, died at 12:15 p.m. Saturday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, following a heart attack suffered only moments before.

A member of the First United Methodist church, Mr. Feasel retired in 1968 from GE after 25 1/2 years of service.

Born in Blue Creek Township on August 4, 1907, he was the son of Charles and Emma Saum-Feasel, and was united in marriage on Nov. 29, 1928 to Margaret Huser, who survives.

Also surviving are one son, Richard W. Feasel, Decatur; one sister, Mrs. William (Annis May) Brown, Decatur; three brothers, Heber Feasel, Albion; Vilas Feasel, Fort Wayne; Marion Feasel, New Haven; three grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
