Leo M. Feasel Sr., 69, 511 Line St., died at 6:40 a.m. Tuesday in Lawnwood Regional Medical Center, Fort Pierce, Florida.

He was born on June 14, 1924 in Adams County to Heber L. and Mildred Smitley Feasel and married Betty J. Hill on January 27, 1951. She survives.

He was a former employee of the General Electric Co. and served as administrator of Adams County Home (now Golden Meadows) for a number of years. He was a member of American Legion Post 43 in Decatur, Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 6236 in Decatur, the Fraternal Order of Police, and St. Mark's United Methodist Church. During World War II, he served in the U.S. Army Air Corps.
