

Dora S. Fleming, 97 years old of Decatur, Indiana, passed away at 5:27 a.m. on Monday, December 19, 2011 in the Woodcrest Nursing Center located in Decatur. Dora was born on Sunday, May 24, 1914 in Adams County, Indiana the daughter of the late Ernest Doehrman and the late Minnie (Fuhrman) Doehrman. She married the late Lee K. Fleming on November 5, 1932 in Richmond, Indiana and he passed away in 2002.
