DECATUR Ind., Nov.13. - John T. France, the well-known lawyer and politician, died at 10 o'clock last evening. His son Richard, who is the big right guard of the Michigan football team, and who was in the game at Philadelphia Saturday, arrived too late to see his father alive, owing to the fact that the message was withheld by the manager of the team. A peculiar circumstance attendant upon the death is that Mr. France predicted, two weeks ago, while in apparently good health, that he would not live thirty days.
