

DEE FRYBACK, 74, DIES; ILL 4 WEEKS

President of the Decatur Hospital Board, of which he was a member 28 years, a brother of Mrs. Clyde (Emma) Coffield of Bluffton and an uncle of Mayor William Fryback, Dee D. Fryback, 74, of Decatur died at 9:15 a.m. Sunday in Parkview Hospital after an illness of four weeks.

Born July 6, 1899 in Wells County, he was a son of William and Ida Alice Avery Fryback. His marriage was to Ireta Beaver, who survives. Mr. Fryback was formerly engaged in the operation of a furniture business, the Fryback Coal Co., and was a salesman of the Burk Elevator Co.

Surviving, in addition to the wife and sister, are a daughter, Mrs. Herbert (Kathleen) Hahn of Fort Wayne; a brother Charles Fryback of Fort Wayne, and two grandsons.
