

WIDOW OF DEE FRYBACK, IRETA FRYBACK DIES AT AGE OF 83

Mrs. Ireta Fryback, 83, of Fort Wayne and formerly of Decatur, widow of Dee Fryback, died at 7:38 p.m. Friday at Parkview Hospital.

A native of Adams County, she was born Oct. 14, 1900, a daughter of E. A. and Mary Alice Parrish Beavers. Her marriage to Dee Fryback, who died in 1974, took place Feb. 4, 1922.

Mrs. Fryback had helped for years in the former Beaver-Fryback-Beavers Furniture Store, served as secretary of the former Fryback Coal Co., both in Decatur, and had assisted her husband when he managed the Decatur Auto License Bureau.

She was a member of the First United Methodist Church, American Legion Auxiliary and the So-Cha-Rea Club in Decatur.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Herbert (Kathleen) Hahn of Fort Wayne; one brother, Glen P. Beavers of Worthington, O., and two grandsons.
