

**2 DECATUR MEN DIE OF FUMES IN CABIN**

DECATUR - Hubert M. Wolf, 49, and Carl A. Frysinger, 61, both of Decatur, were found dead at 9:15 a.m. Saturday of fumes from a space heater in a motel on U.S. 224, two miles east of here.

They were in a cabin at the Belmont Motel.

Dr. Elmer Winteregg, coroner, said their death had occurred about 2 a.m. Saturday.

State police said one of the men had unknowingly bumped into the stove, dislodging the pipe leading out of the cabin. Wolf was sitting in a chair, Frysinger was in bed.

Wolf is survived by two children, his parents, a brother and a sister. Services will be at 3 p.m. Tuesday at the Zwick Funeral Home.

Rites for Frysinger, who is survived by two sisters, will be at the same funeral home at 10 a.m. Tuesday.
