Mrs. Lura Fuhrman Is Taken By Death

Funeral services will be held Tuesday for Mrs. Lura Fuhrman, 63, wife of Charles A. Fuhrman, of Preble, who died at 1:45 p.m. Saturday at the Adams county memorial hospital. She had been ill two weeks of coronary occlusion but death was unexpected.
