

Paul C. Gause Dies After Brief Illness

Funeral services will be held Saturday for Paul C. Gause, 45, of 505 Mercer avenue, who died at 11:10 a.m. Wednesday at the Adams county memorial hospital, a few hours after he had been admitted.

He was born in Whitley county June 21, 1920, a son of Cecil R. and Vera Draper-Gause, and was married to Harriet Eley Sept. 21, 1942. He had lived in Decatur most of his life.

Mr. Gause, an employe of the General Electric Co. plant in this city, was a member of the Loyal Order of Moose.
