PAUL B. GOULD DIES AT HOSPITAL

Paul B. Gould of 454 Line St., Geneva, brother of Clyde Gould of Decatur, died at 2:30 a.m. today at Parkview Memorial Hospital, Fort Wayne. He had been hospitalized 10 days following a brief illness.

Mr. Gould and his wife, Francetta, operated the Kozy Korner restaurant in Geneva for the past 22 years. He was the immediate past street and water commissioner in Geneva. He had been a conservation officer in Huntington county for five years prior to moving to Geneva.

Mr. Gould attended the Geneva Nazarene church and was a member of the Monroe Lodge in Decatur and the Geneva Lions club for 20 years.

He was born in Marion on November 12, 1901, the son of J. H. and Sarah Burkhead-Gould, and was married to Francetta Everett.

Surviving are the wife; one daughter, Mrs. C. J. (Agnes) LaPlount of Osceola, Fla.; one sister, Mrs. Russell (Rosamond) Burnau of Fort Wayne; two brothers, Clyde Gould of Decatur and Percy Gould of Geneva; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. One son preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at the Zwick funeral home, with Rev. David Whitteberry officiating. Burial will be in Decatur cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 7 p.m. Tuesday. Preferred memorials are to the cancer fund.
