

Margaret J. Grimm Dies This Morning

Funeral Services Sunday Afternoon

Mrs. Margaret Jane Grimm, 85, a resident of Decatur practically her entire life, died at 3:15 o'clock this morning at the Davis nursing home at Bluffton, where she had resided for the past two years. She has been seriously ill for the past six weeks.
