

Mrs. Lafe Grimm Dies Friday Night

Mrs. Mary Rosemond Grimm, 42, wife of Lafe Grimm, of Eiting Acres, west of Decatur, died at 8:05 o'clock Friday evening at the Adams county memorial hospital. She had been ill for the past three years and hospitalized for nine weeks.

She was born in Wren, O., April 27, 1917, a daughter of Milton and Edna Maude Shelley-Hart, and was married to Lafe Grimm Sept. 9, 1936. She graduated from the Decatur high school in 1936.

Mrs. Grimm was a member of the First Baptist church and the missionary society of the church.

Surviving in addition to her husband are a son, Thomas K.
