

## ATTACK FATAL TO HARVEY HAGGARD

Harvey L. Haggard, 66, of Monroe, father of Robert L. Haggard of Ossian died at 6:15 a.m. Monday at Lutheran Hospital. Death, due to a heart attack, followed an illness of two weeks.

Born Oct. 25, 1899 in Adams County, he was a son of Henry and Effie Mix Haggard. His first marriage was to Barbara Smith, who died in 1956. His marriage to Veda Crist, who survives took place in 1958.

Mr. Haggard, an agent for the Columbus Mutual Life Insurance Co. since 1935, had taught school in Wells, Adams and Allen Counties 45 years before retiring.

He was a member of the Monroe Methodist Church, Decatur Masonic Lodge, lifetime member of the Indiana State Teachers Association, Fort Wayne Scottish Rite, American Red Cross and the board of the Adams County Tuberculosis Association.

Surviving, in addition to the wife and son, who is Wells County coroner, are another son, David of Indianapolis; two daughters, Mrs. Richard (Carol) Cashman and Mrs. Max (Joyce) McNeal, both of Fort Wayne; two stepdaughters, Mrs. Paul Nussbaum of Decatur and Mrs. George Morgan of Schenectady, N. Y.; a brother, Enos of Indianapolis, and nine grandchildren.
