Lewis K. Hammond Dies Last Night - Funeral Services Thursday Afternoon

Lewis K. Hammond, 76, retired brick-mason and citizen of Decatur for the past 53 years, died Tuesday evening at 6:30 o'clock at his home at 316 Line Street. Death was attributed to complications.

The deceased was born in Van Wert county, O., May 13 1867, a son of David and Martha Frisinger-Hammond.
