Harold G. HARVEY, 80, Decatur, Ind., died Saturday at 9:30 p.m. in the Veterans hospital in Marion where he had been a patient 18 months.

A conservation officer in Fulton County in the late 1930s and 40s, Mr. Harvey assisted in organizing conservation clubs in this area and in Harrison County.

He was born Aug. 7, 1898 at Kirkland to James and Zora GREGG HARVEY. His marriage was to Francile BERGER on April 9, 1921. A veteran of World War I, he was a retired employee of the General Electric company at Decatur.

Surviving are the wife; two daughters, Mrs. Dean (Dixie) ARVEN, Logansport, and Mrs. Jane LANDIS, Columbia City; two sons, Donald and Gary [HARVEY], both of Decatur. Two sons and a brother proceeded in death.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday in the Winteregg-Linn- Haggard funeral home in Decatur. Burial will be in Decatur.
