Naomi M. Hay, 78, a resident of Decatur for many years and formerly a resident of San Jose, Calif., died at 7:07 a.m. today at Adams County memorial Hospital. She had been in failing health for five years.

She was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and the Rosary Society. Born on July 23, 1910, in Decatur, she was the daughter of Samuel and Ida Johnston-Whitright, and was married to Albert Hay on Feb. 22, 1936, in Fort Wayne; he died Jan. 5, 1975.
