Roger A. Heller, 59, of Decatur, a member of Zion United Church of Christ, died Wednesday, Aug. 12, at Lutheran Hospital.

The Adams County native was a member of the American Legion Post 43, Moose Lodge 1311 and served with the Indiana Air National Guard. He was sent to France with the Fort Wayne Guard unit during the international crisis created when the East Germans and Soviets began building the Berlin Wall.

Surviving are his wife, Karen; sons, Kevin of Kentland and Scott of Fort Wayne; a daughter, Shawny Sharpe of Newburgh; his father, Oscar "Duffy" of Decatur; and five grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a brother, William.
