

Former School Principal Dies at Huntington

Clyde W. Hendricks, 62, of R.R. 1 Andrews, former principal at Rudisill and Adams schools here, died at 8:00 p.m. Monday in Huntington County Hospital after a five-year illness.

A native of Monroe in Adams County, he taught in Monroe Township and Adams County 11 years before coming to Fort Wayne in 1924. From 1920-24 he served as principal of Monroe Township School in Adams County.

He was principal of Rudisill School from 1927-35 and at Adams from 1935-47. He taught at Harmar from 1924-27 and at Franklin from 1947-51. He retired as a teacher in 1951.

Mr. Hendricks was a member of the Methodist Church, Masonic, Eagles and Moose lodges, Scottish Rite and Shrine.

Survivors include the widow, Anna; a son, Richard, College Park, MD; two daughters, Mrs. Allan Horn, Evansville, and Mrs. Robert Nye, Indianapolis, and one brother, Howard, Monroe.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Thursday at the Gillig & Doan Funeral Home in Decatur, the Rev. Ralph Johnson officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur Cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home until the time of the services. The family has requested the omission of flowers.
