Funeral services for Mr. Charles J. Hill, 85, of Decatur, IN, will be conducted at 1 p.m. today, Wednesday, June 12, 2002, from the chapel of Zwick & Jahn Funeral Home in Decatur with Minister Jim Voglewede and Minister John Demarzio officiating.
