DONALD HILL DIES AT HOME SUNDAY

Donald V. Hill, 66, who operated a radio, bicycle and lawn mower shop at his home died at 7 a.m. Sunday at his home, 1216 Elm Street, after an illness of two weeks.

Born in Decatur, Sept. 21, 1903, he was a son of Charles T. and Minnie Beatty-Hill, and was married to Grace Wright Aug. 31, 1942.
