Miss Fanny Hite dies at hospital

Miss Fanny Hite, of 323 Winchester street, a native of Decatur and resident of this city most of her life, died at 5:10 p.m. Saturday at the Adams county memorial hospital.

She was a daughter of Henry and Lillie Wilson-Hite, and served for many years as a bookkeeper at the Adams County Bank. She was a graduate of Decatur high school. She lived in Decatur with the exception of five years in California and five years in Chicago.

Miss Hite was a member of the Presbyterian church, the Mary Martha circle of the church, and the Tri Kappa sorority.

Surviving are a sister, Miss Margaret E. (Madge) Hite, of 323 Winchester street; three nieces, Mrs. Arthur (Virginia) Nutting of Vero Beach, Fla., Mrs. David (Jane) Reilly of Whittier, Calif., and Miss Mary Jo Hoffman of Decatur; and three nephews, Robert Hite of Greenwich, Conn., William Wallace Hoffman of Nashville, Ind., and Phillip Thad Hoffman of San Francisco, Calif. A sister, Mrs. Mary Hoffman, died in 1937, and a brother Hugh D. Hite, died in 1938.

Funeral rites will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Winteregg-Linn funeral home, with Rev. Elbert A. Smith, Jr., officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home until 12 noon Tuesday. (no date)
