James O. Hoagland Dies This Morning

Funeral Services Monday Afternoon

James O. Hoagland, 73, lifelong resident of Adams county, died at 12:30 o'clock this morning at his home, 1110 West Monroe street following a year's illness. He had been bedfast for the past four months.

He was born in Union township Oct. 23, 1876, a son of William and Anetta Geist-Hoagland. He was first married to Ida Mallonee, who died in 1908. He later married her sister Ada, who died Jan 16, 1948.
